Why is it so critical to preserve the War of 1812 Pension Records?

Right now, there are 180,000 Pension Records from the War of 1812 housed at the National Archives, a total of 7,200,000 pages. This year marks the **200th anniversary** of the start of the War of 1812, a war some hail as our second Revolutionary War. **So digitizing these fragile records now is timely.**

Why is there such urgency for your support today?

Ancestry.com has generously agreed to step up and cover half of the costs of the project to digitize the War of 1812 pension records so that each dollar donated goes twice as far.

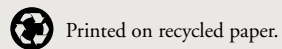
But time is of the essence. These documents are fragile and need to be digitized quickly to preserve the best possible image of each page.

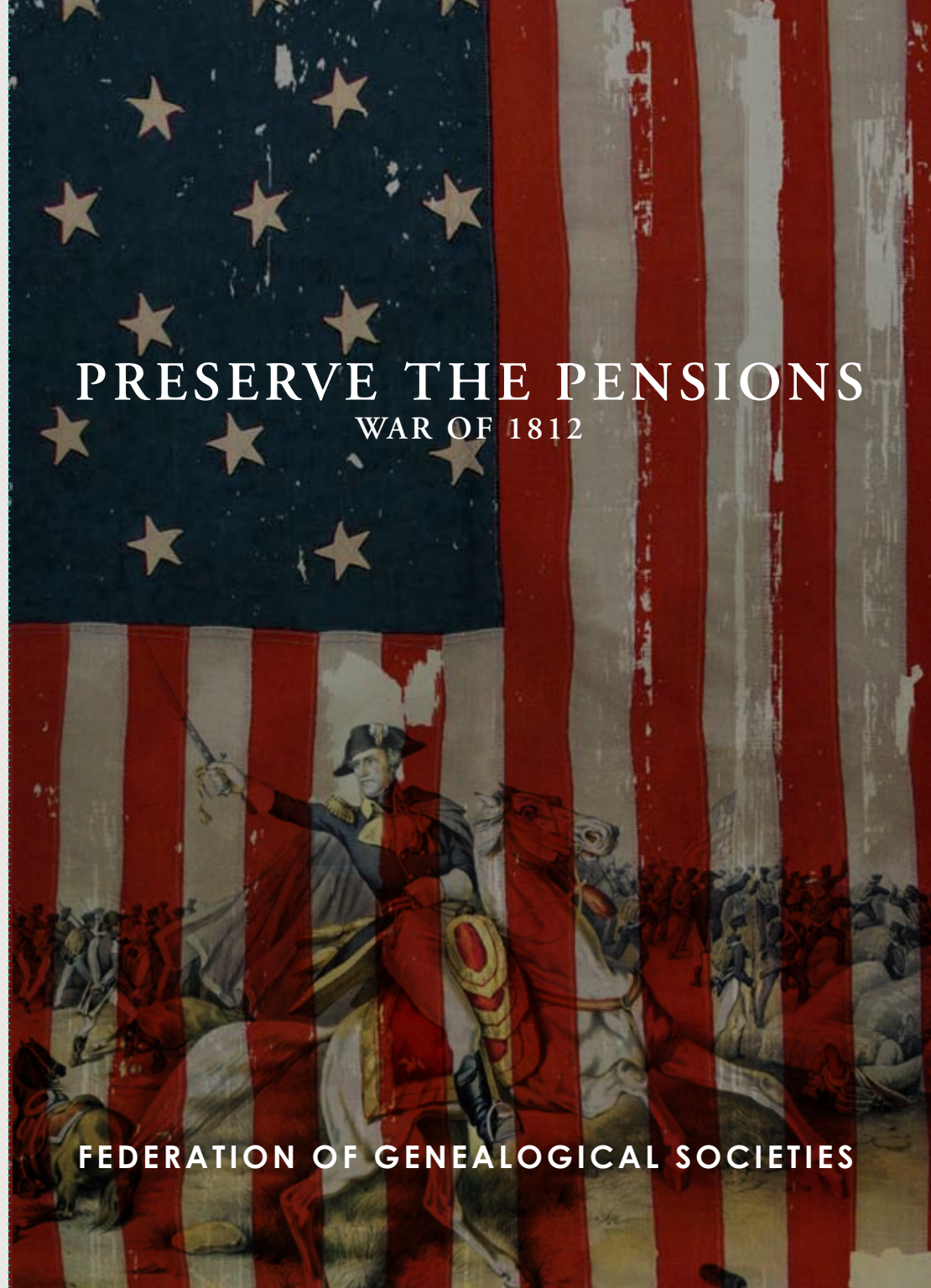
